ILO

No fundamental right to work HS exists in ILOs 9 founding labor conventions (child labor, forced labor, EEO).

- 2,78 million workplace deaths, 374 million non-fatal workrelated injuries and illnesses each year
- IOHA lobbying at next ILO meeting (Global Commission on the Future of Work) – for ILO to add a convention on HS as a right



ILO projects

- where ILO would like to develop guidelines, or expertise and persons to help them with the project itself (on location)
- a week long to 4-month projects and even longer
- they want occupational hygienists involved
- IOHA will be a conduit for ILO to find occ hyg expertise –
 IOHA will vet and endorse applications, and provide a pathway through IOHA website to apply for ILO projects



World Health Org (WHO) International Commission on Occ Health (ICOH)

WHO – focus on primary health care and air quality in developing nations – not worker health
