

# **Call for Posters!**

The NZOHS Work-Related Health Conference 2021, themed “Change is in the Air” will be hosted in Wellington, New Zealand on 1 September 2021 with a social event scheduled the night before on 31 August 2021.

We welcome any work-related health topics with the preferred focus on occupational exposures, associated health effects and occupational health research, but related topics will be considered. The approach this year is not designed to be a formal poster competition but more an open event to allow all worker health practitioners to share a project or projects which they feel is interesting and would benefit their peers.

Posters must be on display for the duration of the conference and submitters should be available to answer questions during tea breaks.

A popular vote from all attending delegates will determine the poster winner who will be announced at the end of the conference and presented with an award.

## **Guidelines:**

- Keep displays simple and text brief, readable (at least a 24 point type size for the main text) at a distance of at least one metre.
- Mount on a single A0 sheet of card (approx. 1200 x 800mm).
- Include title, author/s, author affiliations (institute or workplace) and only the most pertinent data on the poster.
- References and acknowledgements may also be included.
- Use sentence case (upper and lower-case) type throughout the poster.
- Print all text using a laser printer.
- Use bold and/or italics for emphasis.
- The poster is a visual format. Use plenty of graphical elements.
- Photographs should be enlarged to be clearly seen at a distance of one metre and printed with a matte finish (to reduce glare).
