Statement of Service Performance

New Zealand Occupational Hygiene Society Incorporated For the year ended 31 March 2025

Description of Entity's Outcomes

The New Zealand Occupational Hygiene Society ("NZOHS") is a network of occupational hygiene professionals who further the practice, professionalism and recognition of the industry in New Zealand.

At present the Society's membership is made up of Professional Occupational Hygienists either working for large companies, private consultants, or for Worksafe NZ. The Society has also welcomed into its midst, as Associates, a larger number of people who are working in the field of health and safety but have only a part time interest in Occupational Hygiene.

What is Occupational Hygiene?

Occupational hygienists are involved at the interface of people and their workplaces. They use science and engineering to prevent ill health caused by the work environment specialising in the assessment and control of risks to health from workplace exposure to hazards.

Occupational Hygienists help PCBUs and workers to understand these risks and to minimize or eliminate them. The term Occupational Hygiene is generally defined as "the art and science dedicated to the Anticipation, Recognition, Evaluation, Communication and Control of environmental stressors in, or arising from, the work place that may result in injury, illness, impairment, or affect the well-being of workers and members of the community"; and states that "these stressors are normally divided into the categories Biological, Chemical, Physical, Ergonomic and Psychosocial."

Objective of NZOHS

The objective of NZOHS is to improve the calibre of practitioners of occupational hygiene within New Zealand, NZOHS is actively working on raising the profile (with assistance from WorkSafe NZ and HASANZ funding) of Occupational Hygienists and pathways in New Zealand. This financial year includes a portion of the 2nd year and a portion of the 3rd and last year for the 'Continuing to grow the occupational hygienist workforce' project, initiative that had a completion date of 30 June 2024. For reference, this initiative started on the 30 September 2021 and encompasses three years funding allocation with clear milestone and reporting requirements.

1. Statement of Accounting Policies

STATUTORY BASIS

New Zealand Occupational Hygiene Society Incorporated is incorporated under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908.

REPORTING ENTITY

The reporting entity is as identified by the rules of the Incorporation and governed by the committee of New Zealand Occupational Hygiene Society Incorporated and includes all activities carried out under the control of the committee.

BASIS OF PREPARATION

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Special Purpose Framework for use by Not For Profit Entities (SPFR for NFPEs) published by Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand. The financial statements have been prepared for taxation and management purposes. The Society has elected to include a Statement of Service Performance in the financial statements.

SPECIFIC ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following specific accounting policies have been adopted by the Society in the preparation of the accounts.

(a) Changes in Accounting Policies

All accounting policies were applied on a consistent basis during the year.

(b) Goods & Service Tax

These financial statements have been prepared exclusive of GST (except for Trade Receivables and Trade Payables which are inclusive of GST).

(c) Income Tax

Income tax is accounted for using the taxes payable method.

(d) Accounts Receivable

Accounts Receivable are stated at their estimated realisable value.
